According to National Endowment for the Arts (NEA) research:



Rural counties that are home to performing arts organizations experienced population growth three times higher than rural counties that lack performing arts institutions.



Rural counties that house performing arts organizations provide residents with higher incomes (up to \$6,000 higher) than those lacking performing arts organizations.



Two out of three rural businesses report arts and entertainment as important for attracting and retaining workers.

National experts agree that the arts, culture and creative sector make important contributions to driving rural economic development, building rural communities and changing the narrative of rural areas.

According to a 2018 National Governors Association (NGA) expert roundtable discussion, arts and culture contributions to rural areas include:

- Mitigating geographic isolation by building connections.
- Diversifying regional economies by attracting visitors, businesses and investment.
- Injecting pride and enlivening rural communities.
- Improving quality of life.
- Promoting inclusivity.
